



Requirements for participating in an International Academic Exchange Program: Incoming International Students

- Be a full-time student at the University of Origin during the academic semester you are applying for and throughout the duration of the exchange program at the Universidad Privada Norbert Wiener.
- Have a passing grade point average equivalent to a fourteen on a twenty-point scale (equivalent to a 70 on a 100 point scale) when applying for the exchange program.
- Must not have deserved or received any disciplinary sanctions by your school of origin, in accordance with their code of conduct.
- Must not have any outstanding debts with your University of Origin when applying for the exchange program.
- Must have a valid Visa and/or Passport at the time of acceptance to the exchange program.
- Must obtain and maintain active international health insurance with coverage for the entirety of their stay while participating in the exchange program.
- The student is responsible for financing the exchange program, including airplane tickets, housing, room and board, supplies, etc.
- Fulfill all requirements set forth by the University of Origin to enter an Academic Exchange Program.
- Provide the paperwork required by the UPNW as part of the Admissions packet, detailed in the document titled "Admissions Packet Requirements for Incoming International Academic Exchange Program Students".
